Pledge of Allegiance

Plummer Davidson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Visitors

Mr. Friend expressed concerns about Nick riding his bike through his yard while completing meter readings. After discussion, the Board agreed that Nick will dismount before entering Mr. Friend’s property and complete the meter reading on foot.

Previous Minutes (Motion to Approve)

LuAnn Bruno made the motion to approve the March 23, 2026 meeting minutes, seconded by Ethel Kellerman. The motion carried.

Treasurer, Budget Reports/Payment of Bills (Motion to Approve)

Ethel Kellerman made the motion to approve and authorize payment of the bills as presented, seconded by Jonathan McClure. The motion carried unanimously.

Old Business

Usage Report: 350,000 gallons for March.

Leak Detection: They have repaired the saddle that was leaking on Market Street and located a leaking service line. Leak detection efforts are still ongoing.

Delinquent Accounts: Second bills were sent last Friday to 104 customers. Delinquent accounts are now down to 84, with a remaining balance of

\$26,125.92. We still have an active line at 201 Turnpike, and 401 Broadway is scheduled to proceed to the sheriff's sale. Jeff Stover, the solicitor, has sent the Sheriff's Office a copy of the amount owed.

Backflow Inspection Program: All backflow inspection reports are currently up to date. The next set of letters will be mailed on June 1.

HRG Engineer

Matt Deskevich reported that the Chapter 110 report was submitted to DEP on March 27, 2026. He also noted that the 2025 Consumer Confidence Report must be distributed to customers by July 1, 2026, with certification to DEP due by October 1, 2026.

New Business

Water Rules Changes (Motion)

Jonathan McClure made the motion to approve all Water Rule changes as presented, seconded by LuAnn Bruno. The motion carried.

Niagara Discussion

Michaela Bressler asked Jeff Stover, the solicitor, to bring all correspondence related to Niagara to the meeting. Jeff reviewed the meetings, communications, and agreements he has been involved with that are currently on record.

Banking Changes

Jonathan McClure made the motion to move the Authority's banking to First National Bank, seconded by Ethel Kellerman. The motion carried.

Auditor

We expected a quote from Catalano, Case, Catalano & Clark-Radzieta, LLP for this meeting; however, it has not yet been received. The matter will be tabled until the next meeting pending receipt of the quote.

Universal Locks

Jonathan McClure made the motion to approve the purchase of universal locks, seconded by LuAnn Bruno. The quote from Valley Ace Hardware was \$129.90 for all matching locks. The motion carried.

Adjournment

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Ethel Kellerman and seconded by LuAnn Bruno. The motion carried unanimously.
