Water service will be shut off for these accounts tomorrow in accordance with the Authority's Water Rules and Regulations. Many of the accounts scheduled for shutoff are repeat

late-payment customers who have been notified multiple times throughout the billing cycle.

**Backflow Inspection Program:** The Secretary/Treasurer reported that Robbins' inspection has been received. Three additional inspections remain outstanding and are due to expire on April 1, 2026.

**HRG Engineer:** Matt Deskevich reported on the upcoming annual reporting requirements. He also noted that Michaela requested a rough estimate of the cost to replace the Runville Road infrastructure.

**Paula Hall Pension Account**
